How to join a live event: Using a smartphone or tablet

1. To join on a smartphone or tablet, you must first download the Microsoft Teams app. Download from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store. You will need your Apple or Google Play Store username and password. In the app store on your phone or tablet, in the search box, type in “Microsoft Teams”. Tap to download.



Once the application is downloaded to your phone or tablet, you do not need to sign up to create an account.

3. On the date and time of the event you would like to join, click “Click Here to Join” from the calendar of events on our website.
4. Launch the Teams app or watch on the web instead.
5. Click “Join as Guest”.
6. Enter your name or initials, as you would like it viewed by others.
7. Hit “Join Meeting” to connect.
